THE COURT FINDS AND ORDERS THAT

3. PETITION FOR ENFORCEMENT

- a. The parties are to comply with the terms of the *Postadoption Contact Agreement*, as the court has found both of the following:
- (1) The petitioner has made good-faith attempts to resolve the issues through mediation or other appropriate dispute resolution, and
 - (2) Enforcement is in the best interest of the child.
- b. The petition to enforce is denied because
- (1) the petitioner has not shown that there have been good-faith attempts to resolve the issues through mediation or other appropriate dispute resolution.
 - (2) enforcement is not in the best interest of the child.

4. PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OR TERMINATION

- a. The petition for modification termination of the *Postadoption Contact Agreement* is granted, as all parties, including the child if 12 years or older, have signed the petition or submitted written consent or have executed a modified agreement that has been filed with the petition.
- b. The petition for modification termination of the *Postadoption Contact Agreement* is granted, as the court has found ALL of the following:
- (1) The best interest of the child will be served,
 - (2) There has been a substantial change of circumstances since the original agreement was approved, and
 - (3) The petitioner has made good-faith attempts to resolve the issues through mediation or other appropriate dispute resolution.
- c. The petition for modification termination is denied because
- (1) it is not necessary to serve the best interest of the child.
 - (2) there has not been a substantial change of circumstances since the original agreement was approved.
 - (3) the petitioner has not shown that there have been good-faith attempts to resolve the issues through mediation or other appropriate dispute resolution.

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5. ORDER FOR INVESTIGATION OR EVALUATION
- a. The petition is taken under submission.
 - b. The court orders an investigation or evaluation of the issues raised in the petition based on a finding **by clear and convincing evidence of both of the following:**
 - (1) The best interest of the child may be protected or advanced only by such inquiry, and
 - (2) The inquiry will not disturb the stability of the child's home to the child's detriment.
