Pursuant to Chapter 189A of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and by ORDER of the District Court, you are hereby notified **your privilege to operate a motor vehicle in the Commonwealth of Kentucky is suspended** this ____ day of _____, 2_____, for the following reason(s):

- refusal to take an alcohol concentration or substance test(s);
- second or subsequent conviction or prior driving under the influence offense;
- second or subsequent license suspension / revocation for refusal to take alcohol concentration or substance test(s) in the five (5) year period immediately preceding arrest; OR
- involvement in accident resulting in death or serious physical injury, as defined in KRS 500.080, to a person other than defendant.

[] For a Kentucky driver: Your license shall remain suspended until a judgment of conviction or acquittal is entered in the case or until the court enters an order terminating the suspension, but in no event for a period longer that these **maximum** license suspension periods (Select one):

- first offense within 5 year period - 120 days; second offense within 5 year period - 18 months;
- third offense within a 5 year period - 36 months; fourth or subsequent offense within 5 year period - 60 months.

Any operators' license in your possession must be surrendered to the Court immediately. If you want the judge to review the suspension, you must file a Motion for Judicial Review of License Suspension. A hearing will occur within 30 days of filing the request.

[] For a non-Kentucky driver: Your privilege to operate a vehicle within the boundaries of the Commonwealth of Kentucky is hereby suspended for a period of _____ days and/or _____ months.
