5. **IT IS ORDERED** that showup of the juvenile be authorized. Juvenile and parent, guardian, or legal custodian shall first be advised of the right to an attorney and shall have the opportunity to consult with an attorney and have the attorney present during the identification process. The juvenile, parent, guardian, or legal custodian are also advised that if the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian cannot afford an attorney, the court will appoint an attorney for the juvenile if requested on the record or in writing by the juvenile or the juvenile's parent, guardian, or legal custodian.

6. **IT IS ORDERED** that  fingerprinting  photographing  other: of the juvenile be authorized and filed with the court within 14 days of the order, unless the time period is extended by order of the court. The identification shall be filed in the social file, capable of being located and destroyed on court order.

### **MCR 5.923 Miscellaneous Hearing Procedures**

**(C) Fingerprinting and Photographing.** The court may permit fingerprinting or photographing or both of a minor when the minor is in court custody. Fingerprints and photographs must be placed in the confidential files, capable of being located and destroyed on court order.
