ADVICE OF LEGAL RIGHTS

If you are a party, you have a right to be represented by an attorney. If you desire to employ an attorney, you should do so immediately in order that s/he may be ready at the hearing date. If you are financially unable to employ an attorney, you must notify the court immediately upon receipt of this notice. If you have a court appointed attorney, you may be required to reimburse the court in whole or in part for the cost of such services.

Court rules require the appointment of an attorney for minors in certain cases. If your child(ren) fall under this category, an attorney will be appointed by the court.
