

## Criminal History Check Release

Minnesota Statute requires that the Court shall determine whether any person that is seeking to have their name changed has been convicted of a felony in this or any other state.

To comply with Minn. Stat. § 259.13, you must supply the following information and attach this document when you file your application. You must complete a separate form for each party covered on the application, including a form for each minor that is 14 years of age or older.

If there has been a felony conviction, both the court administrator and the name change applicant must report the name change to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension within ten days of the date of filing. (See instructions for additional information.)
