This action must be advertised, unless the subject person is petitioning under his/her own election.



Form PC-9.2, Attorney of Record, should be completed and filed with the estate records.

If a person, by reason of disability or upon his/her own election, is unable to properly care for property owned, the Probate Court may appoint a Conservator of the property upon petition of one or more relatives or friends.

The Attorney or Petitioner:

- Presents **Form PC-2.10, Conservatorship**, for filing.

The Probate Court:

- **If the person for whom the Conservator is to be appointed is not the Petitioner**, orders a **Citation** to be served on said person at least 14 days before the hearing.

The Probate Clerk:

- Enters the proceedings of the Court.



For the Court's information, the Probate Clerk should request a physician's statement from the Attorney.
