Form PC-9.2, Attorney of Record, should be completed and filed with the estate records.

Section A - Petition for Release from Guardianship

- This form allows the Ward, who has once again become competent or who has attained majority, to be released.
- A Physician's Statement must accompany this Petition.
- Both the Guardian and the Ward must sign this petition.

The Attorney or Petitioner:

- Presents the form for filing.

The Probate Clerk:

- Assigns a hearing date.

Section B - Discharge to Guardian

This form allows a Ward who has once again become competent or reached the age of majority to discharge a Guardian.

The Attorney or Petitioner:

Determines that the Guardian has:

- Paid all bills due from the estate.
- Paid or delivered to the Ward all money and property remaining in the estate.

Then, the Ward may execute **Form PC-2.9, Discharge to Guardian.**
