This form must be filed by a Commissioner within 10 days after the notice of appointment.

- The Commissioner must file with the Probate Clerk a certificate of the engagement signed by the officer before whom he/she is engaged.
- This Certificate attests to the faithful discharge of the duties.

The Probate Clerk:

- Notifies the Commissioner of his/her appointment.

After receiving the completed Certificate

- Ascertains that the **Form PC-6.1, Certificate of Engagement of Commissioner**, has been signed by a Notary Public attesting that the Commissioner will hear and determine disallowed claims.
- File date stamp.
