This form is a report filed by a Commissioner appointed to examine and determine disallowed claims in an insolvent estate.

- An Executor or Administrator at any time during administration may represent the estate insolvent to the Probate Court.
- The Fiduciary may apply for a Commissioner to examine and determine claims.
- If the Court finds the estate to be probably insolvent and there have been claims that have been disallowed, the Court shall appoint a Commissioner.

The Fiduciary:

- Sends a notice to the disallowed creditors.

The Probate Clerk:

- Attaches a copy of the individual notice sent by registered mail to each creditor whose claim was disallowed.
- Date stamps file.
