I. BASIS

A motion for the adjustment of child support has been presented.

II. FINDINGS

Based on the motion, the court FINDS that:

It has been 12 months since the order was entered and the guidelines upon which child support was previously calculated were based upon age and the child is no longer in the age category.

It is more than 24 months since the order was entered and there has been a change in the incomes of the parties.

- It is more than 24 months since the entry of the decree or the last adjustment or modification and there have been changes in the economic table or standards in RCW 26.19.
- It has been 12 months since the order was entered and the order provides for support to be periodically adjusted and the court should compel an adjustment making it effective with the date first specified in the order.
