I. ADVICE

An Order of Disposition having been entered, you are now advised that:

- 1.1 You have the right to appeal or seek review by a higher court of:
 - The finding of guilt after a trial.
 - A disposition of manifest injustice.
- 1.2 Unless a Notice of Appeal is filed with the clerk of the court within thirty (30) days from the entry of the Order of Disposition, you cannot ever appeal.
- 1.3 If you have no lawyer to file a Notice of Appeal for you, the clerk of the court will, if requested by you, file a Notice of Appeal on your behalf.
- 1.4 If you cannot afford the cost of an appeal, you have the right to have a lawyer appointed to represent you on appeal and to have such parts of the trial record as are necessary for review of the errors which you allege copied for you, all at public expense.
