

FORM SUMMARY

Name of Form: Order for Assessment and Evaluation for Intensive Sanctions
Form Number: CR-220

Statutory Reference: s.973.032(2), Wisconsin Statutes

Purpose of Form: The court can require the Department to review the possibility of a sentence to intensive sanctions even if the Department does not recommend it in the original PSI.

This Order is the direction to complete such a review and file a copy of it with the court by a certain date (such as the sentencing date).

Who Completes It: The judge or the clerk at the direction of the judge.

Distribution of Form: Original is filed with the Clerk of Court. Copies go to Division of Intensive Sanctions, district attorney, defense attorney, and defendant.

Accompanying Forms: A copy of the presentence investigation is to be included with the order that is sent to the division. Only the order itself is sent to the other distributees.
Also, presumably all relevant materials would be sent with the defendant and this Order. This would include such things as the criminal complaint, medical and/or psychiatric or psychological reports, etc.

New Form/Modification: Modification of 10/92 version.

Modification: An address has been changed for one of the Division of Intensive Sanctions Sectors. The sector previously located in Menasha is now located in Oshkosh.
