Name of Form: Consent Decree

Purpose of Form: To record an agreement between the parties requiring certain actions or activities to be done in exchange for suspending formal proceedings. The court official approves the consent decree and orders the parties to comply with it.

Who Completes It: Generally one of the interested parties in the proceedings for presentation to the court official for approval and signing.

Distribution of Form: Original to court, copies to those who signed the consent decree and any service providers.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modification, previous update 11/99.

Modifications: Changed “that” to “the” in the first line.
