**Name of Form:** Dispositional Order--Protection or Services (Chapter 938)

**Form Number:** JD-1746

**Statutory Reference:** §§938.34, 938.345, 938.355, 938.396(7)(a), Wis. Stats.

**Benchbook Reference:** JV 8-74

**Purpose of Form:** Formal order of the court detailing the disposition in a ch. 938 juvenile in need of protection or services (JIPS) case (this does not apply to a chapter 48 *child* in need of protection or services).

**Who Completes It:** District attorney/corporation counsel.

**Distribution of Form:** Original to court, copies to juvenile, parent/guardian/legal custodian/trustee, juvenile's attorney, district attorney/corporation counsel, social worker, and other interested parties.

**Accompanying Forms:** Permanency plan, if available. If out-of-home placement is ordered, form JD-1753, Notice Concerning Grounds to Terminate Parental Rights, must be attached.

**New Form/Modification:** Modification; last update 01/01.

**Modifications:** Under court finding 5b, changed statute reference to 938.355(3d). Under court finding 5c, changed instruction to read "(Complete one of the following, if applicable.)"

Previous modifications: Revised a finding under #4 to comply with provisions of the Adoption and Safe Families Act of 1997 and Final Administrative Rules 45 CFR Parts 1355, 1356, 1357. Under #4 of the order added a place to indicate a reason for the placement. Also, added space to indicate the efforts to prevent removal and a space to indicate why efforts were not required.

**Comments:** In a delinquency out-of-home placement to a foster home, treatment foster home, group home, or child caring institution placement, the court must make a specific finding that the current residence "will not safeguard the welfare of the juvenile or the community" (§938.355(1)). Such a finding is not required for similar JIPS out-of-home placements.

Other findings may need to be individually added to the "other" section to specific issues.
