<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	Initiate a proceeding in court to enforce the Order for Financial Disclosure Statement.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	The party seeking to enforce the Order for Financial Disclosure Statement. This party would be the plaintiff in the small claims action in which a judgment was awarded and an Order for Financial Disclosure Statement was rendered by the court.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Original to court with copy to be served upon the debtor.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	None.
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modification; last update 10/00.
<b>Modification:</b>	<p>Changed court order #4 to read: “If the judgment creditor does not appear at this hearing, this motion may be dismissed.”</p> <p>Changed statute reference on form summary from §799.36 to §799.26.</p> <p>Previous modifications: Changed the word “Petition” to “Motion” in the title since the statute refers to the procedure for enforcement as a motion. Changed language in para. 3 to eliminate the reference to “contempt” since the hearing is not an order to show cause hearing. Also eliminated this reference in para. 1 of the order. Changed the service portion of the order requiring personal service as the primary service since a contempt finding for non-appearance could result in imprisonment. The court upon request can allow alternative service for good cause.</p>
<b>Comments:</b>	§802.01(2)(a), Wis. Stats., requires that a notice of the motion be “served”.
