Purpose of Form:	Formal order of the court detailing the disposition in a ch. 48 child in need of protection or services (CHIPS) case (this does not apply to a chapter 938 <i>juvenile</i> in need of protection or services).
Who Completes It:	Corporation counsel or district attorney.
Distribution of Form:	Original to court, copies to juvenile, parent/guardian/legal custodian/trustee, juvenile's attorney, district attorney/corporation counsel, social worker, and other interested parties.
Accompanying Forms:	Permanency plan, if available. If out-of-home placement is ordered, form JD-1753, Notice Concerning Grounds to Terminate Parental Rights, must be attached.
New Form/Modification:	Modification; last update 01/01.
Modifications:	<p>Under court finding 4c, changed instruction to read “(Complete one of the following, if applicable.)”</p> <p>Previous modifications: Modified to comply with provisions of the Adoption and Safe Families Act of 1997 and Final Administrative Rules 45 CFR Parts 1355, 1356, 1357.</p>
Comments:	Pursuant to ASFA Final Rules, judicial determinations must be explicitly documented and made on a case by case basis. The order must contain the child-specific reasons for the court’s decision. Reference simply to state statute to substantiate judicial determinations are not sufficient. Affidavits and <i>nunc pro tunc</i> orders are not acceptable to support determinations related to out-of-home placements.
