Statutory Reference: s. 51.20(7), (8)(bg), and (13)

Purpose of Form: To allow the corporation counsel to request dismissal of a chapter 51 proceeding and the court's order granting the same.

Who Completes It: Corporation Counsel

Distribution of Form: Original to Court, copies to subject, subject's counsel, mental health treatment providers (51.42 board) and other interested persons.

Accompanying Forms: None.

New Form/Modification: Modification, last update 10/97.

Modifications: Added a file/date stamp to upper right corner. Added a statement on the bottom indicating that the form shall not be modified.

Comments: RMC discussed whether notice of the motion must be given to either the subject or other interested persons (such as family members or individuals who have signed a three-party petition) prior to the court signing the order. RMC believes that because the ability to bring these actions exists only with the corporation counsel, nobody else has standing to object and the court cannot order the corporation counsel to proceed over objection. RMC believed that by including appropriate individuals in the distribution schedule, notice of the dismissal will be given.
