Name of Form:	Order of Commitment or Dismissal
Form Number:	ME-911
Statutory Reference:	§51.20(13), Wis. Stats.
Purpose of Form:	To order dismissal or involuntary commitment of a subject and designate a treatment facility or outpatient services.
Who Completes It:	Completed in court by corporation counsel or court.
Distribution of Form:	Original to court, copies to subject, counsel, treatment provider, and detention facility (if different). Also, copies to the Supreme Court and Board of Attorneys Professional Responsibility (if the subject of a finding of mentally ill, drug dependent or alcoholic is an attorney).
Accompanying Forms:	An order for involuntary medication and treatment form (ME-905) may be attached. If the commitment is for an outpatient with conditions, a copy of the conditions must be attached to this order.
New Form/Modification:	Modification, last update 4/00.
Modifications:	Added a file/date stamp to upper right corner. Added a statement on the bottom indicating that the form shall not be modified. Added statement to comments section of form summary to remind the court that SCR 21.07 requires filing a copy of specified findings and orders made relating to an attorney with the Supreme Court and Board of Attorneys Professional Responsibility.
Comments:	Supreme Court Rule 21.07 requires a court finding an attorney mentally ill, drug dependent or alcoholic to file a copy of the findings and order with the Supreme Court and Board of Attorneys Professional Responsibility.
