

## FORM SUMMARY

**Name of Form:** Notice and Motion for Medication and Treatment and Order for Hearing

**Form Number:** ME-917

---

**Statutory Reference:** s. 51.61(1)(g)

**Purpose of Form:** To allow an interested person to request a hearing to determine if the court should order medication and treatment.

**Who Completes It:** Either the corporation counsel or the physician seeking the treatment order.

**Distribution of Form:** Original to Court, copies to subject, subject's counsel, corporation counsel, mental health treatment providers and other interested persons.

**Accompanying Forms:** If the motion is filed by the corporation counsel, the motion must have attached a report (if there is one) or a signed statement by the physician asserting that, based on an examination of the subject, the subject needs medication and treatment and is not competent to refuse.

If the motion is filed by the physician directly, the required statement is included in the motion itself and no further documentation is needed. However, if a report has been made, it may be included with the motion papers.

**New Form/Modification:** Modification, last update 5/98.

**Modifications:** Added a statement on the bottom indicating that the form shall not be modified.

**Comments:** This form would be used after a finding of probable cause or after a final commitment order has been made and the subject is refusing medication and treatment.

**About this form:** This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.
