

FORM SUMMARY

Name of Form: Affidavit for Transfer of Property (\$10,000 and Under)

Form Number: PR-1830

Statutory Reference: §867.03, Wisconsin Statutes

Benchbook Reference: PR 8-15

Purpose of Form: When a decedent leaves solely owned property in Wisconsin which is \$10,000 or less in value, an heir or person who was guardian of the decedent at the time of the decedent's death may have that property transferred by completing this affidavit and furnishing it to the person who holds the property.

Who Completes It: The heir or person who was guardian of the decedent at the time of the decedent's death.

Distribution of Form: Original and duplicate original must be provided to the holder of the property. If required, a copy of this affidavit must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the Department of Health and Family Services.

Accompanying Forms:

New Form/Modification: Modification, last update 06/00.

Modifications: In paragraph 6, changed language for clarification.

Previous modification: Modified form to comply with 1999 Wisconsin Acts 9 and 94.

Comments: This form is used for deaths occurring prior to May 9, 2000. For deaths on or after May 9, 2000 use form PR-1831.

About this form: This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.
